

## REGULATIONS OF THE 60TH EUROPA RALLY - KRAKÓW 25-29 MAY 2023

### 1. Preliminary provisions

- a) Full name of the event: Caravanning Rally 60th Europa Rally
- b) Duration of the event 25.05.2023 -29.05.2023
- c) Place of the rally: Polish Aviation Museum, Krakow al. Jana Pawła II 39
- d) Organiser: Polski Związek Motorowy with its seat in Warsaw at 66 Kazimierzowska Street, 02-518 Warsaw, registered in the Register of Associations in the District Court for the City of Warsaw, 13th Economic Division of the National Court Register under No. 0000036662, Tax Identification Number (NIP) 521-033-48-79.
- e) Co-organisers: Malopolska Tourist Organisation, City of Krakow, Globe-Traveler.
- f) A Rally Participant is any member of the crew who has purchased a place at the Rally.
- g) Each Participant of the Rally is obliged to familiarise himself/herself with these Regulations.
- h) Participant taking part in the Rally accepts these Regulations and undertakes to abide by them.

### 2. Registration for the Rally

- a) Electronic registration via [www.europarally2023.com](http://www.europarally2023.com) is obligatory for the Caravanning 60th Europa Rally.
- b) The price of the rally includes:
  - Admission to the rally for those declared in the registration form,
  - Rally badges
  - Rally package - information leaflets, gadgets and gifts from the organiser and partners
  - Access to electricity connection and use of electricity
  - Access to sanitary facilities in the form of shower and washbasin containers. 3.

### 3. Organisational matters and registration of crews

- a) All organisational matters during the event will be handled by the Rally Office.
- b) Rally Office hours
  - Wednesday 24 May - 12:00-22:00
  - Thursday 25 May - 8:00 am to 10:00 pm
  - Friday 26 May - 8:00-10:00 14:00-16:00
  - Saturday 27 May - 8:00-10:00 14:00-16:00
  - Sunday 28 May - 8:00 am - 10:00 am
- c) At the Rally Office each crew will receive a Rally Pack (one per crew) and badges - one for each crew member.
- d) The package will be issued after confirmation of registration and acceptance of the regulations by signing two copies of the regulations, one for each crew and the organiser.
- e) The rally area is divided into sectors, for each country separately.
- f) The allocation of plots is decided by the rally staff.
- g) Plots are numbered
- h) Each crew is obliged to occupy the parcel to which they will be directed by the rally staff.

### 4. Entry to and exit from the rally area

- a) Arrival of crews at the rally area will take place during the rally office operating hours.
- b) Departure of the crews after the Rally is over - 29 May by 17:00 at the latest.

### 5. Insurance and liability

- a) Each Participant takes part in the Rally at his/her own risk and in addition should have a current third party insurance policy for his/her vehicle taking part in the Rally in accordance with current Polish law.
- b) The participant, by staying at the rally and by the fact of receiving the Rally Pack, waives all rights to compensation, which may arise in connection with an accident which may occur during the rally. This waiver applies to the Rally Organiser and the Co-organisers.
- c) The Organiser is not liable for any loss of a Participant occurring during the Rally and no third party insurance premium is included in the Ticket price.
- d) Each participant of the Rally bears direct and full responsibility for the consequences of his actions, including in particular responsibility for damage and losses caused to other participants of the Rally and third parties.

### 6. Order and safety during the rally

- a) The Rally area is under Night Quiet: from 23:00 to 6:00 each night.
- b) It is strictly forbidden to drive any vehicle in the Rally area in a way that might endanger the health, life or property of other Rally Participants.
- c) Persons under the influence of alcohol, whose condition indicates excessive consumption or intoxication, as well as persons behaving in an aggressive manner, may be forced out of the rally area by the relevant security services employed by the Organiser.
- d) Participants in the Rally must not undertake any activities that pose a danger or threat to the health and life of other Rally Participants.
- e) It is prohibited to take animals on optional excursions. Participants are allowed to have animals on the rally site, provided that they do not cause trouble or harm to other rally participants. The animal must be supervised by its owner, who at the same time is obliged to clean up after its excrement.

### 7. In matters not regulated by these Rules and Regulations the applicable provisions of Polish law shall apply.
